

(xv) To print or publish or get printed or reprinted books on tribal culture, history, literature, philosophy, traditional science/knowledge, system of thought, exoteric language of others.

(xvi) To organize or participate in course of study, research and seminars.

(xvii) To promote and review the various classical and folk dances, dramas, music, arts, crafts and xylographic works.

(xviii) Any other activity subservient to the aims and objectives of the society.

RULES AND REGULATION OF THE OCEAN

1 Name :

The name of the society shall be "OCEAN" hereafter called the organisation.

2 Funds :

The Society will be authorized to raise funds and manage moveable and immovable property placed at its disposal.

- a) The society shall collect funds through voluntary subscriptions, donation, gifts, subsidies incentives and endowment, Government grants or grants from other bodies interested in the activities of the society. It shall acquire buildings or land for the aims and objectives stated in the memorandum of Association, relating the power to sell, mortgage or dispose of these properties in any way deemed fit by it.
- b) The society shall purchase necessary equipment and for receive it as gifts or donations.
- c) The Association shall ask for and accept loans from Govt or would itself raise loans from others sources.

3 Accounts :

The financial year of the society shall be from 1st April to 31st March each year its accounts will be opened as follows :

- a) All the money shall be kept in a scheduled bank as be convenient for the society to open. The President and the Society will on behalf of the society jointly the account.
- b) The Treasurer shall prepare form the income and expenditure as well as the assets and liability statements. The accounts shall be approved by the Managing Committee before submission to be auditor.
- c) The duly audited accounts shall be presented to the Annual General Meeting by the Managing Committee.
